The LifeChange Center

The LifeChange Center, a br 28,500 square foot building at the corner of N.W Third and Burnside streets in downtown Portland opened in January 2007. The LifeChange Center houses men and women in Union Gospel Mission's LifeChange recovery community. LifeChange is a Christian, long-term and transforming addiction recovery community.
